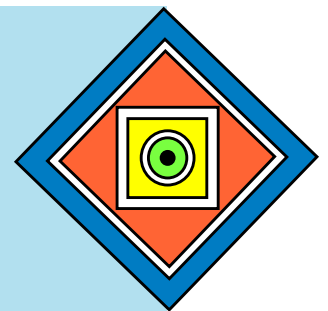

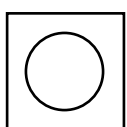
Absorbed by Color

CONCENTRIC Challenge

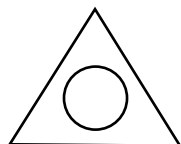
Concentric shapes share a center point, appearing to be “nested” inside one another. (See example on right.)
